

MINUTES
WAYCROSS CITY COMMISSION MEETING
TUESDAY, JANUARY 22, 2019
5:00 PM

The Commission of the City of Waycross held their Regular City Commission Meeting on Tuesday, January 22, 2019 in the Commission Chambers of City Hall. The meeting was called to order by the Honorable Mayor John Knox at 5:00 p.m. Members in attendance were: Mayor John Knox, Commissioners Jon Tindall and Marian Solomon-Gaines. Commissioners Norman Davis, John Threat, and Diane Hopkins were absent.

Mayor John Knox asked Public Works Director Wilton Deloach to pray the opening invocation. The Invocation was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance led by Mayor John Knox.

Mayor John Knox announced that due to the lack of a quorum, no official business can be transacted.

Mr. Geoffrey Meeks addressed the Commission regarding the lack of parking in the downtown area around Pierce Drugs, St. Vincent's and Dr. Galea's office. He proposed making Brunswick Avenue one way with angled parking. Marc Hawkins and Gene Thomas are to meet with him and review the parking.

Ms. Latrena Hodge, St. Vincent's Cardiology, requested that the City review the lack of wheelchair accessibility and hand rails around the building.

Interim City Manager, David Eddins, announced that Public Works building project will be going out for bids with bid opening on January 23, 2019. Mr. Eddins thanked the City and County residents for voting for and approving the SPLOST, making Fire Station 4 possible as well as the new Public Works building which is being funded by SPLOST.

Following last call, Mayor Knox adjourned the meeting.
