WAYCROSS CITY COMMISSION MEETING

TUESDAY, APRIL 18, 2017

The Commission of the City of Waycross held their Regular Meeting on Tuesday, April 18, 2017 at the City Auditorium. The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by the Honorable Mayor John Knox. Members in attendance were: Mayor John Knox, Mayor Pro Tem Jon Tindall, Commissioners Marian Solomon-Gaines, Larry Ethridge, Diane Hopkins and Norman Davis.

Commissioner Marian Solomon-Gaines offered the opening invocation. The Invocation was followed Star Spangled Banner and the Pledge of Allegiance led by HR Director Trinija Martin.

Under Executive Duties, the winning participants of the Annual Art Coloring Contest were awarded certificates.

The Award of Valor Was presented to Zavier James by the Waycross Fire Department.

Mr. Roger Collins was appointed Ex-officio City Marshal by motion from Commissioner Norman Davis; seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Jon Tindall; and approved by unanimous vote.

The City Manager's Report included a thanks to the citizens of Waycross and the sponsors of the Coloring Contest, stating that it was a great way to start off Georgia Cities Week. Mr. Maddox commended Sloan Fountain and Elizabeth Velez-Hill for a great job with Swampfest. He also thanked the Waycross Journal Herald for the great coverage.

There were no public remarks on official action.

Mayor Knox presented the Consent Calendar as read by City Clerk Julie Dinkins for consideration of official action as follows:

Approval of Minutes: Approval of the Waycross City Commission Planning & Information Session, Monday, March 20, 2017; Waycross City Commission Meeting, Tuesday, March 21, 2017.

No Ordinance Second Readings, Consent Resolutions or privilege licenses renewals were presented.

The Consent Calendar was approved by motion from Commissioner Marian Solomon-Gaines; seconded by Commissioner Norman Davis; all voted in favor and the motion carried.

Purchasing Director Linda Jones presented Bid FY17-07 Mosquito Control Chemical. Purchasing has received 2 bids on mosquito control chemical. After review staff recommended awarding the bid to Adapco, Inc. of Sanford, FL as being the lowest and best bid meeting all specifications. Adapco, Inc.'s bid came in a \$16.54 per gallon for Pursuit 4-4. Adapco is our

current vendor and we have received great service from them. Commissioner Marian Solomon-Gaines made the motion to approve the bid as presented. Commissioner Norman Davis seconded the motion; all voted yes and it was approved.

An Ordinance to Amend the Code of the City of Waycross, Georgia pertaining to Alcoholic Beverages, One Day or Special Event Alcoholic Beverage Licenses was presented for the emergency first reading.

ORDINANCE NO. 017-06

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE CITY OF WAYCROSS, GEORGIA; TO AMEND CHAPTER 6 – ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, ARTICLE II - LICENSES, DIVISION 2 – APPLICATION, BY ADDING NEW SECTION 6-77, PERTAINING TO ONE DAY OR SPECIAL EVENT ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LICENSES; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO PROVIDE FOR SEVERABILITY; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; TO PROVIDE FOR RENUMBERING OR RELETTERING; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES


