

**MINUTES**  
**WAYCROSS CITY COMMISSION MEETING**  
**TUESDAY, JULY 7, 2015**  
**7:00 P.M.**

The Regular Session of the Commission of the City of Waycross was held on Tuesday, July 7, 2015 in the Commission Chambers of City Hall. Mayor Clarence E. Billups called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Those in attendance with Mayor Pro Tem Alvin Nelson were Commissioners, Marian Solomon-Gaines, Norman Davis and Larry Ethridge. Commissioners Norman Davis and Diane Hopkins were not present.

City Manager Raphael Maddox introduced Bishop John Moss, Pastor for the Church of Christ Written in Heaven who offered the opening invocation followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Under Executive duties, Mayor Pro Tem Nelson announced that a Public Hearing will be held on August 4, 2015 at 6:30 p.m. in the Commission Chambers of City Hall to consider the Annexation and Re-zoning of 721 Donald Street to C-2 Highway Commercial.

Human Resources Director, Trinija Molina-Martin introduced Sharon Radford, Administrative Assistant for Community Improvement as the Employee of the Month for July, 2015.

Pastor Raymond Burch, River of Life Church invited the public, students, and teachers to attend a back-to-school event on July 27 through 31.

City Manager Raphael Maddox reminded the Commission, staff and public that he has a military style of management. Mr. Maddox presented Police Chief Tony Tanner and Community Improvement Director with an "Extra Mile Award" for duty above and beyond in planning and implementing the Fourth of July Celebration.

Mayor Billups thanked Police Chief Tony Tanner and Community Improvement Director Sloan Fountain for a job well done for the July 4<sup>th</sup> Celebration. As well as all City staff who helped with the celebration.

There were no public remarks on official action.

**RESOLUTION NO. 15-28**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WAYCROSS, GEORGIA,  
TO APPROVE AGREEMENT WITH DARNEL QUICK RECOVERY, INC. TO COLLECT  
PAST DUE ACCOUNTS OF THE CITY; AND  
FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Waycross from time to time has utility accounts which become past due and delinquent; and

**WHEREAS**, the services of a collection agency becomes necessary and essential to collect those debts; and

**WHEREAS**, Darnel Quick Recovery, Inc., is willing to contract with the City of Waycross to collect those past due and delinquent debts and a proposed Agreement between Darnel Quick Recovery, Inc. and the City of Waycross has been presented to the Commission of the City of Waycross; and

**WHEREAS**, the Agreement will be effective for an initial term of three (3) years; and

**WHEREAS**, either party may terminate said Agreement, without cause, at the end of the initial term of said Agreement upon giving more than ninety (90) days written notice by certified mail; and

**WHEREAS**, a copy of said Agreement is attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference as if fully set forth herein; and

**WHEREAS**, the Agreement provides that Darnel Quick Recovery, Inc. will collect the City's delinquent debts for a fee of twenty-five percent (25%) of the gross amount collected on all "First Place accounts" and forty percent (40%) of the gross amount collected on all "legal accounts and bankruptcies"; and

**WHEREAS**, Darnel Quick Recovery, Inc. shall remit to the City of Waycross those amounts collected with fifteen (15) days of the end of any given month; and

**WHEREAS**, said matter having been considered.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Commission of the City of Waycross that the Agreement between Darnel Quick Recovery, Inc. and the City of Waycross, Georgia, in the form attached hereto, is hereby approved.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Commission of the City of Waycross that the Mayor and City Clerk hereby directed, authorized and empowered to execute said Agreement on behalf of the City of Waycross, and to ratify and confirm the execution of said Agreement, and to do all the acts and things necessary in order to carry out the purposes and intent of this Resolution.

There being additional changes to be made to the contract with Darnel Quick Recovery, Commissioner Marian Solomon-Gaines made the motion to table this Resolution until July 21. This motion was seconded by Commissioner Alvin Nelson and approved with a 3-0 vote.

**RESOLUTION NO. 15-29**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WAYCROSS, GEORGIA,  
TO APPROVE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GEORGIA  
DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND THE CITY OF  
WAYCROSS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

**WHEREAS**, a proposed Agreement between the Georgia Department of Corrections and the City of Waycross to be effective July 1, 2015, has been presented to the Commission of the City of Waycross, Georgia; and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of said Agreement is for the Department of Corrections to provide one inmate Work Detail on public works projects in accordance with O.C.G.A § 42-5-60 (e); and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to said Agreement, the Department of Corrections will provide one full time Correctional Officer and a maximum of ten (10) inmates for the Work Detail; and

**WHEREAS**, the Agreement shall be effective from July 1, 2015, until June 30, 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, the cost to the City shall be thirty-nine thousand and five hundred dollars (\$39,500.00) for the year, commensurate with labor supplied, and salary and benefits for one Correctional Officer, exclusive of overtime provided by the Correctional Officer in performing the work; and

**WHEREAS**, either Party may terminate said Agreement for convenience upon seven (7) days written notice to the other Party; and

**WHEREAS**, a copy of said Agreement is attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference as if fully set forth herein.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Commission of the City of Waycross, Georgia, that the Agreement between the Georgia Department of Corrections and the City of Waycross, Georgia, in the form that is attached hereto, is hereby approved.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Commission of the City of Waycross, Georgia, that the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized, directed and empowered to execute said Agreement on behalf of the City of Waycross.

The Resolution of the City of Waycross to Approve Agreement Between the Georgia Department of Corrections and the City of Waycross as presented for approval along with the accompanying agreement was approved by motion of Commissioner Marian Solomon-Gaines; seconded by Commissioner Larry Ethridge; affirmative vote and approval.

A Resolution of the City of Waycross to Authorize and Set Annual Residential, Non-profit, and commercial user fees for residences and businesses outside the corporate City Limits of the City of Waycross and in Pierce County as presented.

**RESOLUTION NO. 15-30**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WAYCROSS, GEORGIA,  
TO AUTHORIZE AND SET ANNUAL RESIDENTIAL, NON-PROFIT AND  
COMMERCIAL USER FEES FOR RESIDENCES AND BUSINESSES OUTSIDE THE  
CORPORATE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WAYCROSS AND IN PIERCE  
COUNTY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, effective July 1, 2015, properties in Pierce County have been de-annexed from the corporate city limits and are no longer within the corporate city limits of the City of Waycross pursuant to House Bill 523; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Waycross has served the properties located in said de-annexed area with water, sewer, fire and police protection for many years; and

**WHEREAS**, since these properties are no longer in the corporate limits of the City of Waycross, the City of Waycross, in an effort to continue to serve the unincorporated area in Pierce

County with water and sewer services, wishes to authorize, set and levy an annual residential and commercial user fee which will serve to offset costs to the City in order to continue providing these services; and

**WHEREAS**, under the provisions of Sections 36-29 and 32-92 of the Code of the City of Waycross, Georgia, the rate and charges for the consumption of water and sewer services furnished by the City shall be as determined by the Commission of the City of Waycross from time to time and to be on file in the office of the City Clerk; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission of the City of Waycross has determined that the Annual Residential, Non-Profit and Commercial Annual User Fees for water service should be established for those residences and businesses in Pierce County and presently not within the corporate limits of the City of Waycross; and

**WHEREAS**, said matter having been considered.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Annual Residential, Non-Profit and Commercial Annual Fees set out below shall be effective July 1, 2015:

- Each residential customer of a single family dwelling will pay an Administrative Fee of \$50.00 plus an Annual User Fee of \$500.00, payable at the time water service is established then billed annually and due on January 1 of each subsequent year;
- Each multi-family dwelling (apartments and duplexes) will pay an Administrative Fee of \$50.00 plus an Annual User Fee of \$500.00 per unit, payable at the time water service is established, then billed annually and due on January 1 of each subsequent year;
- Non-profits will pay an Administrative Fee of \$50.00 and an Annual User Fee of \$500.00 payable at the time water service is established then billed annually and due on January 1 of each subsequent year;
- Commercial customers will pay an Administrative Fee of \$50.00 plus an Annual User Fee of \$500.00 for the first ten (10) employees and \$400.00 for each additional employee thereafter. This includes all employees however classified and is to include full-time employees, part-time employees, seasonal employee or workers and contract workers.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that, due to the time frame involved, the City of Waycross will pro-rate the Annual Residential, Non-profit and Commercial Annual User Fees for calendar year 2015 and said fees are to be paid upon receipt.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City of Waycross has determined that the water and sewer rates will be double rate as they were charged prior to the de-annexation and the effective date of House Bill 523; and that any and all charges assessed upon the properties must be paid in full before water and sewer service can be re-established; and this includes all City of Waycross taxes for calendar year 2014 and business licenses for calendar year 2015.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Mayor and City Clerk are directed, empowered and authorized to do all the acts and things necessary in order to carry out the purposes and intent of this Resolution.

Mr. Maurice Mungin addressed the Commission about the Confederate flag.


