Hurricane Preparedness Tips

- ✓ Stock your emergency supply kit with basic survival items. You'll want to have a 2-week supply of water and ready-to-eat, non-perishable food for every family member and pet. If you evacuate, you'll want a 3-day supply of the same. Other items to add to your supply kit include:
 - Manual can opener
 - Essential medicines including eyeglasses and contact lenses
 - Personal hygiene items such as toilet paper, toothbrush and toothpaste
 - Change of clothing
 - Paper towels, hand sanitizer, and eating utensils
 - First-aid kit
 - Battery-powered flashlight and radio with extra batteries
 - Blankets, pillows and sleeping bags
 - 2 coolers—one for food, one for ice
 - Plastic tarp for roof/window repairs and tools
 - Special items for infant, elderly or disabled family members
